Colón, Panama

The history of Colón is punctuated by busy years of construction to facilitate travel. First were the Panama Railroad and the carving out of a quick route for the California Gold Rush. Then, most enduringly

and famously, came the Panama Canal, begun by the French in 1881 and completed by the Americans in 1914.
