Lying quietly on the Cromarty Firth, Invergordon is the gateway to the Highlands region of Scotland. From its early industrial days as one of the main producers of whiskey to its present-day involvement in the repairing of oil rigs, Invergordon and neighboring Inverness are steeped in history. Perhaps Invergordon's greatest claim to fame is the proximity of Loch Ness, the narrow 23-mile-long body of murky water that's said to be home to the elusive monster "Nessie."

Thursday, August 18 **Kirkwall, Orkney Islands, Scotland**

A place of contrasts and balance, Kirkwall offers the high points of a large Scottish city – stellar local shopping and impressive historical sites like the St. Magnus Cathedral and ruins of the Bishop's Palace and Earl's Palace – as well as the charms of a small village. It is a relatively quiet ferry-landing town that is also an excellent example of an ancient Norse settlement, making Kirkwall itself a living museum.
